
Ready to Roommate - The McCarthy Shared Housing Model

The Struggle of \$even

- The median income for those experiencing homelessness in New Haven is \$721 (SSI)
- People have to choose between eating or sleeping with such low incomes
- We needed a non-subsidy housing option for low income single adults

The Model

- <u>Apartments</u> Three bedroom with common areas (kitchen, bathroom, living room)
- Leases Individual six month leases, always renewable
- <u>Rents</u> Never exceed \$500 and as low as \$300
- Groups A six week curriculum reduces anxiety and acclimates clients into housing
- Expectations Roommate to roommate & tenant to landlord are set by the tenants
- <u>Turnover</u> The rooms are a stepping stone, movement equals opportunity
