Get involved with ending family homelessness:

Here is a list of things to do to raise awareness about family homelessness, educate yourself and others, and take action towards ending it.

- ✓ First, explain to your parents what you did in school today. What did you learn about family homelessness?
- ✓ Check out behomeful.org, there is a page titled “Learn” with some great information for all ages to get started.
- ✓ Call someone from out of town, like a grandparent, an aunt or an uncle, and explain *be homeful* to them. Tell them some of the facts you have learned and see what they have to say.
- ✓ Visit a local business with your parents and talk to the manager or owner *about be homeful*. Explain why ending family homelessness matters in your town. If the business owner wants to get involved, offer to give them a marmalade jar to put on their counter to collect donations from customers.
- ✓ Do some research on family homelessness in your town. Write a letter to the editor of the local paper about why people should be aware of the issue.
- ✓ Send *be homeful* a letter, a poem, a short story, a picture etc., about why ending family homelessness matters to you. If you and your parents are okay with us sharing it on Facebook, write a little note when you send us the work at rbeach@cceh.org.
