- New Data Standards
 - Some discrepancies noted especially with SSVF & PATH projects
 - Providers are encouraged to submit PDX error to Nutmeg for resolution
- Maintenance
 - New hardware installed on October 11, 2019
 - Replaced front end application servers live as of October 11, 2019
 - Configuration of google apps to be confirmed
 - Feedback expected from users
- Analysis of merged Client IDs
 - Development of a self- serving dashboard to depict;
 - System wide metrics
 - Usage patterns over time

 - Level of dashboard will be decided at a later date

- BNL Status Tool – **NOTE: THIS IS NO LONGER APPLICABLE AS A NEW BNL TOOL IS BEING DEVELOPED**
 - Outcome of meeting held in June
 - Automation of client details for efficiency and accuracy
 - Updating client status in case worthy for effectiveness
 - Reactivation of returned clients immediately without waiting two weeks
 - Review and possible modification of BNL exit destination to align with ES exit destination
 - A working group including Beau Anderson & Lisa Quach to implement suggestions; contact them if you want to be included
4. Working Session – All
- Granting HMIS Access to Agencies
 - Required Criteria
 - Access would only be given to entities who have relationship with homelessness and must have established a need for access
 - An interface to a separate portal may be created for approved entities
 - MOUs will serve as the application but will contain different languages for full access and view only access
 - CCEH is responsible for handling requests for HMIS access and may include a few SC members
 - The Steering Committee will be involved only when such requests cannot be handled by CCEH & other members
 - Agreed thoughts at the work session will be circulated via email before the next meeting
 - Request for access by a DOH staff member to be discussed outside the meeting
 - CCEH will draft initial standard operating procedure (SOP) based on working session and will distribute for comments via email.
